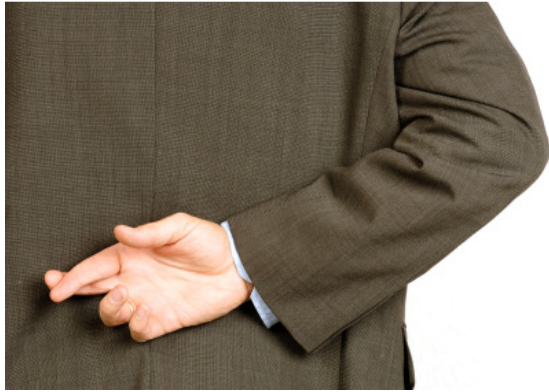


BRISBANE WOMAN Workshop and Networking Evening - Tuesday 9th March
